

**BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN LAKES  
ORDINANCE NO. 1679**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 220 “UNIFORM  
CONSTRUCTION CODES” AND CHAPTER 259 “FIRE PREVENTION”  
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN LAKES  
TO REDUCE FEES FOR BOROUGH-SPONSORED EVENTS**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin Lakes, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph B(1)(c)(19) of §220-2 “Construction Fees” of Chapter 220 “Uniform Construction Codes” of the Code of the Borough of Franklin Lakes is hereby amended to read as follows:

- [19] Temporary installations and decorative displays.
  - [a] Temporary installations and decorative displays for not over 60 days:  
Charge 50% of the schedule for permanent work.
  - [b] No charge shall be less than \$35.
  - [c] Issuance of duplicate certificate (cut-in card): \$25.
  - [d] Minimum electric fee: \$50.
  - [e] *Notwithstanding the foregoing, the fee for a temporary electrical permit for Borough-sponsored events, such as the Town Fair and Memorial Day ceremony, shall be \$20.*

Section 2. Paragraph B of §259-7 “Permits” of Chapter 259 “Fire Prevention” is hereby amended to read as follows:

- B. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:71-2.3(b)4, the following local permits are required and application fees shall be charged as indicated; *except that fees in connection with Borough-sponsored events, such as the Town Fair and Memorial Day ceremony, shall be*

\$20 each.

Section 3. §259-7 “Permits” is hereby supplemented by the addition of the following:

C. *Fees required by this section may be waived for non-profit entities.*

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflict.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Governing Body of the Borough of Franklin Lakes declares that it would have passed the Ordinance and each section and subsection thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.
