

**BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN LAKES
ORDINANCE 1684**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 356 “PARKS AND PUBLIC LANDS”
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN LAKES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin Lakes, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 356-29 “Community Center room rental fee” of Article III “Athletic Fields and Recreational Facilities Use Policy” of Chapter 356 “Parks and Public Lands” of the Code of the Borough of Franklin Lakes is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Paragraph C (“Boating is prohibited.”) of Section 356-31 “Rules and regulations” of Article IV “Franklin Lakes Nature Preserve” of Chapter 356 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Chapter 356 “Parks and Public Lands” of the Code of the Borough of Franklin Lakes is hereby supplemented by the addition of the following:

ARTICLE VI, Parsons Pond Park

§ 356-35. Hours for use.

Parsons Pond Park shall be open for use by the public from dawn to dusk.

§ 356-36. Rules and regulations.

In addition to the rules and regulations set forth in Article I of this chapter, the following rules and regulations shall apply to Parsons Pond Park:

- A. Fishing shall be permitted with a New Jersey State license.
- B. Littering is prohibited.
- C. Boating is prohibited.
- D. Swimming and wading are prohibited.

- E. Motorized vehicles, including but not limited to all-terrain vehicles, are prohibited, except on roadways or in parking lot.
- F. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- G. Fires are prohibited.
- H. Dogs are permitted, provided they are kept on leash.
- I. No ice skating or ice fishing.

Section 4. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflicts.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, part of any section, or clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The governing body of the Borough of Franklin Lakes declares that it would have passed the ordinance and each section and subsection thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.
