Until recently, curbside commingled material was a source of income for the Borough. That has changed. Commingled recycling may become a cost to the Borough which would increase proportionately with the amount of contamination. Plastic bags and Styrofoam are the biggest problem.

**STARTING SEPTEMBER 1, any garbage found
to contain recycling will not be picked up.**
