



Municipal Court - As of September 30, 2020

Traffic violations added - total




Traffic violations added - total: This is the number of tickets that are issued by the Franklin Lakes Police Department as well as the State Police (which is minimal).
 Due to COVID-19 the amount of tickets has declined, however the ticket total has steadily increased.

Traffic violations disposed - total: Includes the total of DWI, moving violations and parking violations adjudicated for the month either by court appearance or payment of ticket where applicable.
 Due to COVID-19 the state has issued a relaxation order so the courts could attempt to handle certain matters via Plea by Mail.


Total Criminal and Indictable offenses added



Total Criminal and Indictable offenses added: This number includes charges of Indictable Offenses, Disorderly Persons Offenses, Petty Disorderly Persons Offenses and Borough Ordinances issued by Franklin Lakes Police, State Police and Borough Officers.

Due to COVID-19 there was a decline in Criminal cases.

Number of Cases Heard



Number of Cases Heard: Number of defendants appearing in regular court sessions. Some defendants may have one ticket and some may have several. This number only indicates the number of defendants that appeared at a court session per month. (please note that in July, August, November and December there is only one session for the month) Typically we have two regular sessions per month and special sessions only as needed.

Due to COVID-19 the court has started to conduct virtual court sessions. The court has been advised to schedule between 10-20 defendants per session because of the lengthy process. The court has been scheduling up to 60 people a session, knowing approximately 20% will fail to appear.
