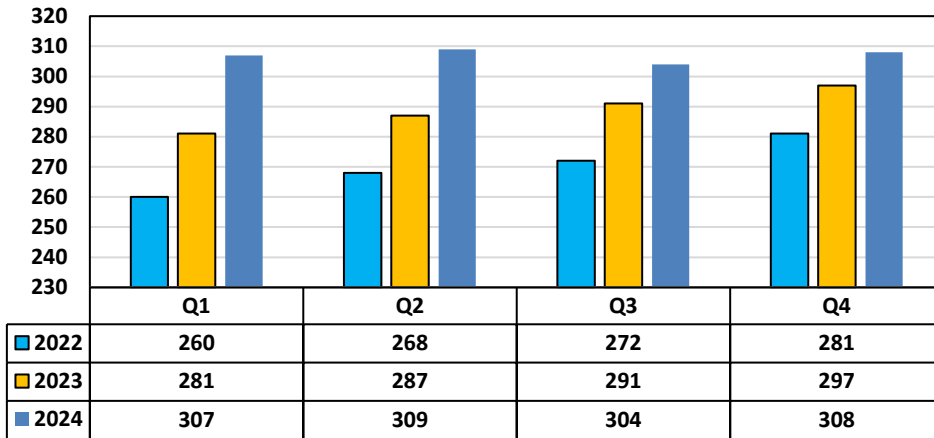

Automatic Withdrawal (ACH) Transactions - number

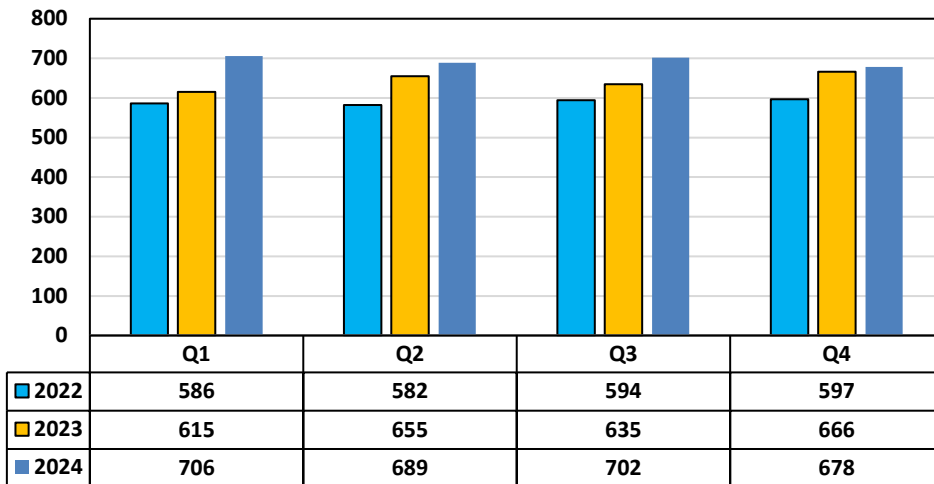


Automatic Withdrawal (ACH) Transactions - number:

The Borough accepts tax payments via a direct withdrawal from your checking account. There is no charge for this service.

As reflected in the graph, the number of residents using this service for 4Q 2024 was 308 and the amount collected \$1,762,079.21. This number fluctuates with sales and purchase of homes, but there has been a increase in the number of users from 3Q 2024.

Number of Online Payments (WIPP)

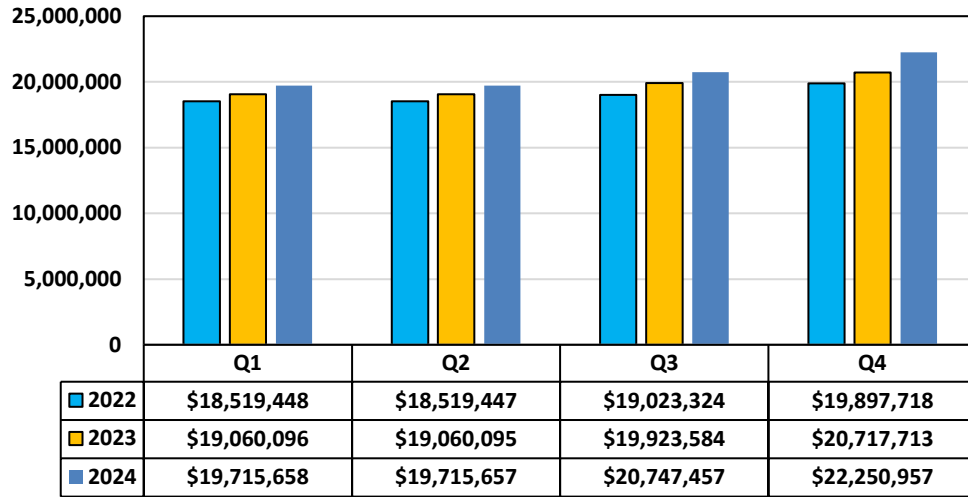


Edmunds WIPP Program - number:

The Borough also accepts online tax payments using E- checks, debit/credit cards through Edmunds WIPP Program. There are convenience fees involved with this service depending on the method being used.

Due to the convenience, there was a significant increase in the number of residents using this service. In 4Q 2024 we had 678 transactions totalling \$4,026,685.58.

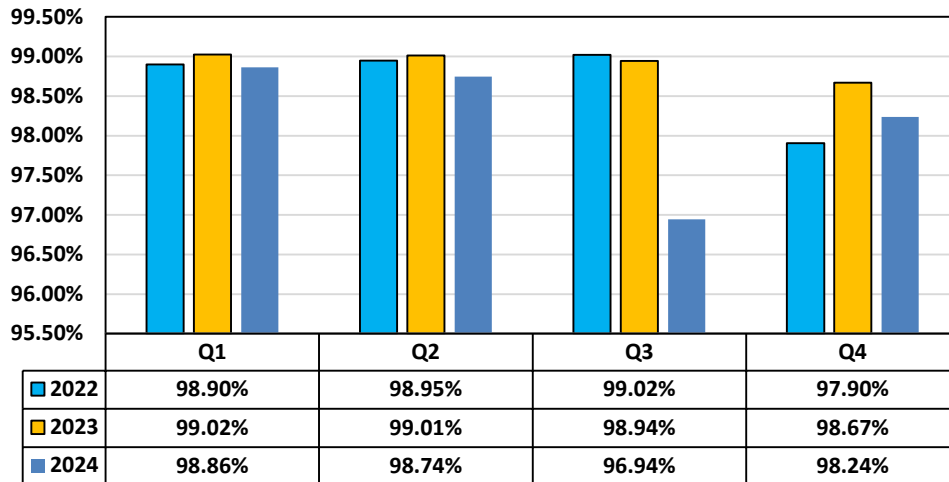
Tax levy quarter



Tax levy quarter: Property tax is the tax liability imposed on homeowners for owning real estate. The Borough uses this revenue to fund programs and services for the entire community, like funding the public school system, law enforcement and emergency services, personnel wages; to install and maintain roadways and road signs; and to pay for trash pickup, snow removal and other services that benefit the community.

The municipal tax authority sets a percentage rate for imposing taxes, called a levy rate, which is then calculated against the assessed value of each homeowner’s property advalorem (literally, “according to value”). The final determination is the individual property tax levy for that resident.

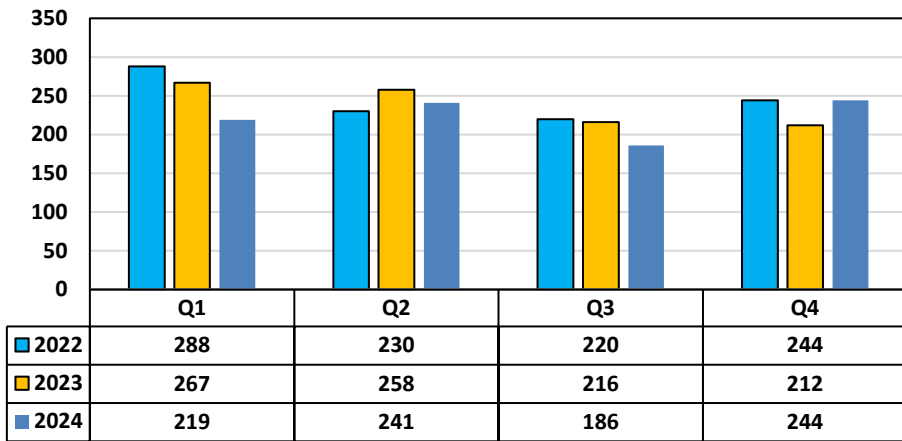
Taxes collected year to date percentage



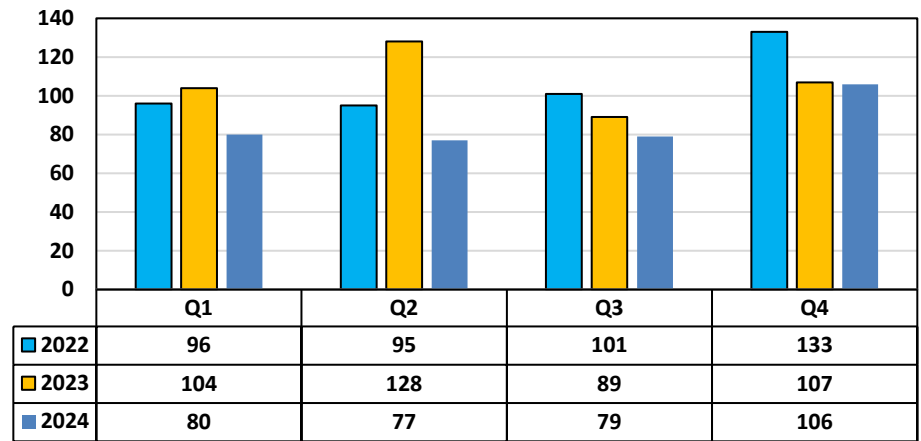
Taxes collected year to date percentage: This graph reflects the year-to-date tax amount collected divided by the year to-date tax levy.

As reflected in the graph, the collection rate for 4Q 2024 taxes was 98.24%. Sending out delinquent notices and making phone calls has helped with the collection rate.

Number of Delinquent Notices Sent: This graph reflects the number of delinquent notices sent out for each quarter. Two delinquent notice mailings are done per quarter.

244 delinquent notices were mailed out on November 14, 2024 and 106 delinquent notices were mailed out on December 6, 2024. As you can see, mailing the delinquent notices helped tremendously in collecting delinquent taxes. As of December 31, 2024 there were 63 delinquent tax payers.
