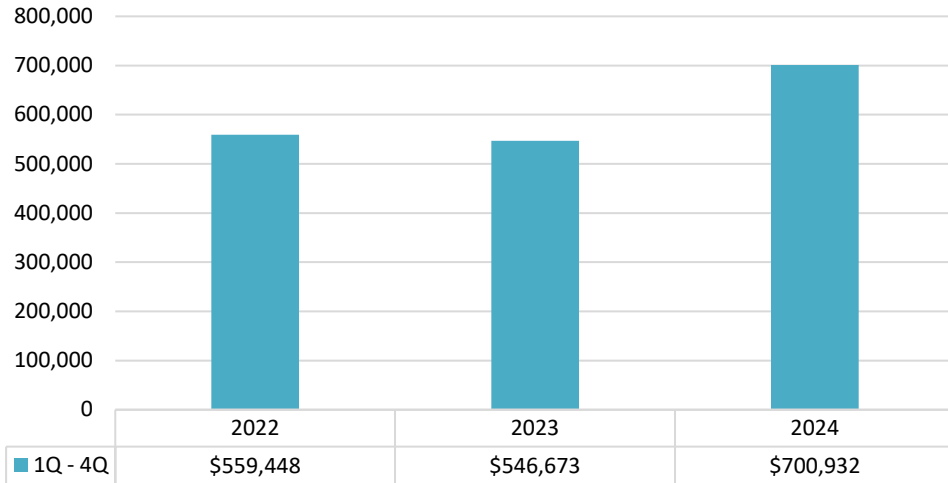


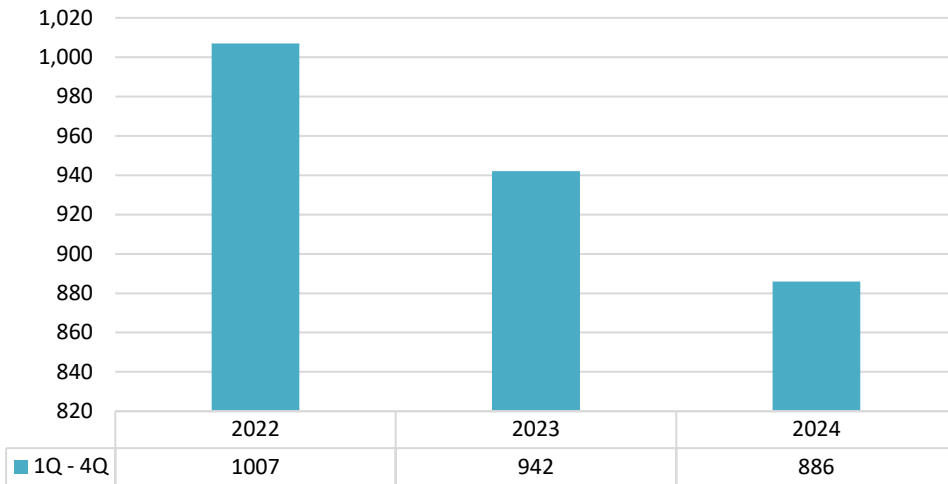

Construction - Total permit fees



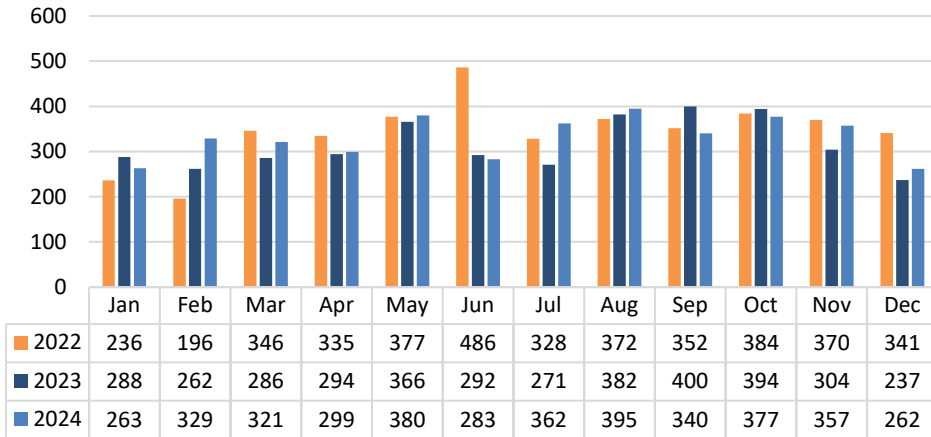
Total Permit Fees: : We have seen a \$132,097 increase in total permit fees collected over the same time period Q1-Q3 YoY.

Construction - Permits issued - total



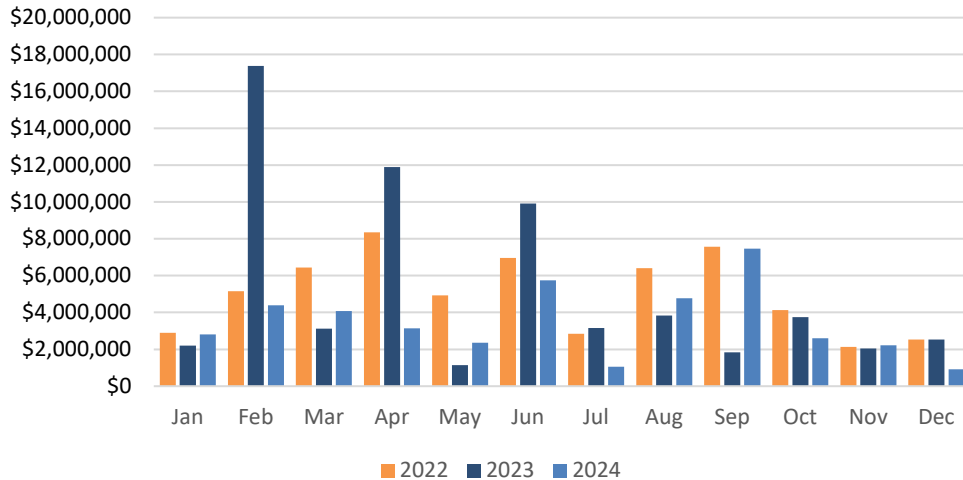
Permit Issued Total: We have seen a minimal decline YTD in permits issued.

Inspections completed - total (all subcodes)



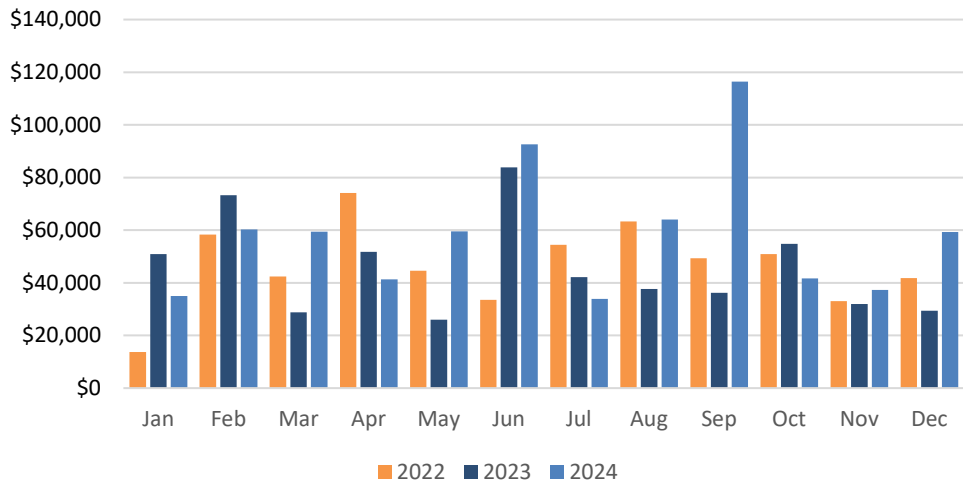
Inspections completed: A strong July, with almost 100 more inspections YoY has Q3 ending with 44 more inspections completed in 2024 vs. 2023. YTD 2024 has 131 more inspections completed vs 2023.

Construction Jobs Cost Estimate



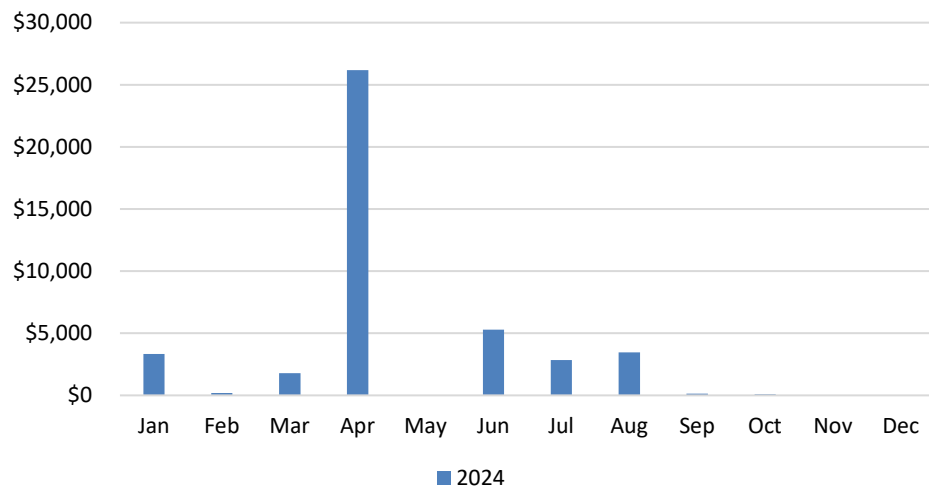
Construction jobs cost estimate (monthly): July saw a decline YoY, However both Aug and Sept are higher compared to same period last year.

Total Permit Fees



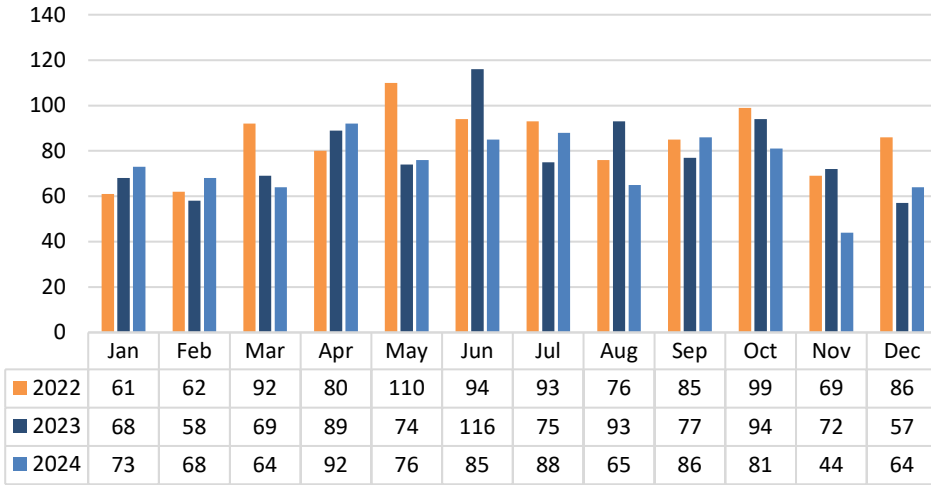
Total permit fees (monthly): We collected over \$20K more in Aug compared to same period last year and saw a significant increase of almost triple in Sept 2024 compared to Sept 2023.

Total Permit Fees Waived



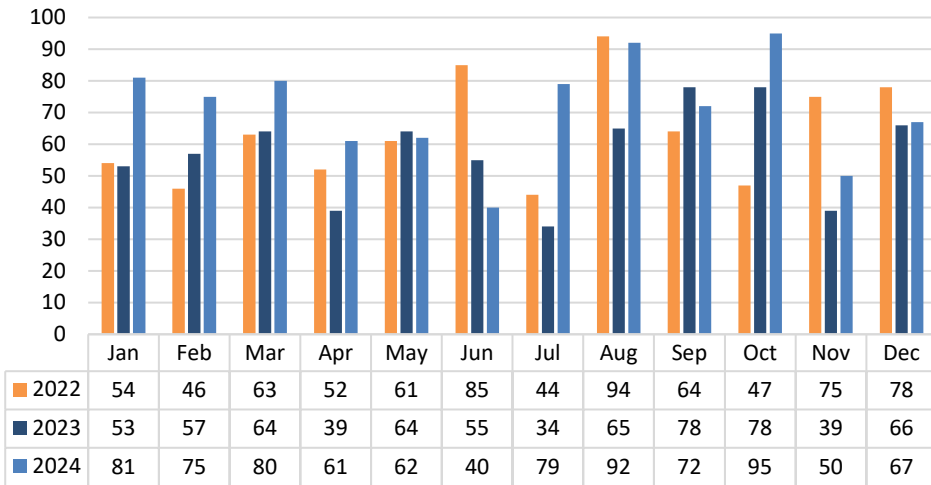
Total permit fees Waived (monthly): Permit fees are waived based upon certain projects in the borough; however, under UCC law inspections need to be conducted at the cost of the borough.

Permits Issued - Total



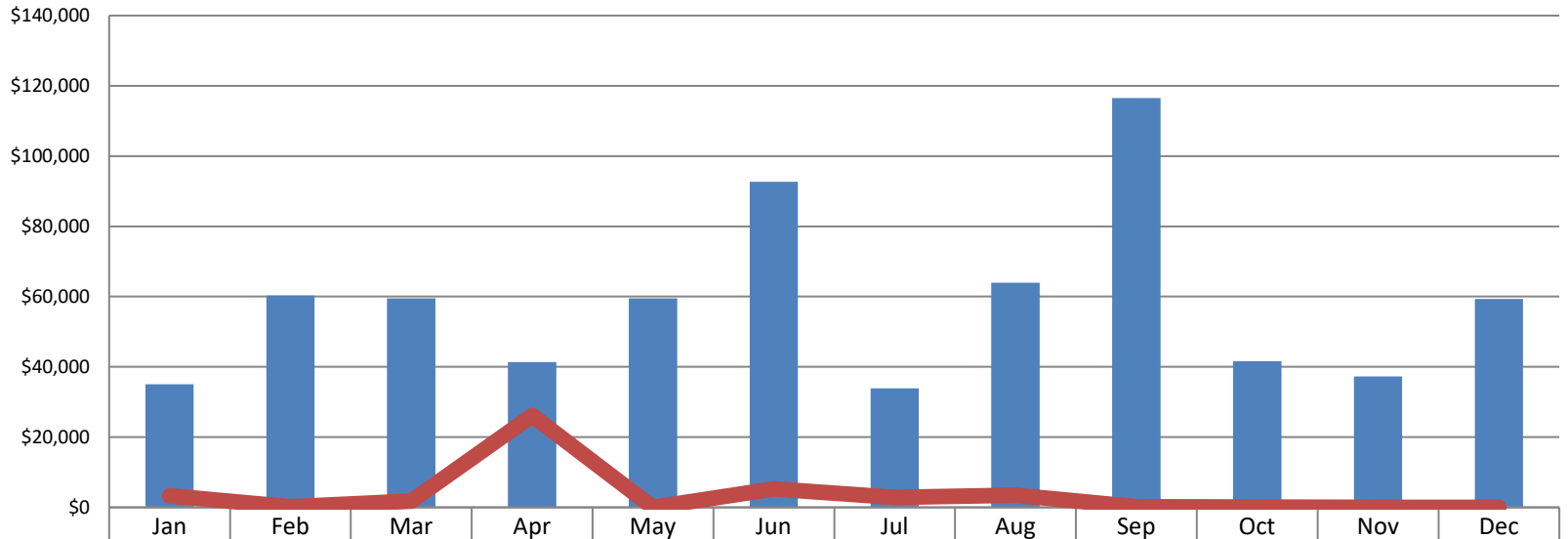
Permits issued total (monthly) A slight decline (6) permits issued in 2024 vs 2023. August 2024 was lower YoY, but Sept bounced back with an increase. This is similar to Aug 2022 where people might be on vacations and not putting in permits until Sept.
